## Quick Review of Polar Biome

- Strong Seasonal Changes
  - About four months with no light per year
- Low annual precipitation
  - 20 inches in Artic
  - 8 inches in Antarctic
- Extreme Cold and Wind
  - Antarctica is coldest and driest continent
